Fees

Tuition fee: 18000CNY/ academic year

Accommodation fee: 6000 CNY/academic year (September to July)

Scholarships

★ Full Scholarship is to reward outstanding new degree students. The tuition fee, accommodation fee of the first academic year will be waived, round trip tickets of the first year will be reimbursed (up to 8000 CNY).

★ “New Student Tuition Waiver Scholarship” is used to reward excellent new international students. “New Student Tuition Waiver Scholarship” is divided into 3 classes: 1st class (100% tuition fee waived for one year), 2nd class (50% tuition fee waived for one year) and 3rd class (25% tuition fee waived for one year).

★ “Merit Students Scholarship” is used to reward current international students in ZISU who are hardworking and excellent. “Merit Degree students Scholarship” is divided into 3 classes: 1st class (8000CNY/person/year), 2nd class (5000CNY/person/ year) and 3rd class (2000CNY/person/ year). Students can apply after one year study.

1. Foreign citizens over 18 years old;
2. Foreign Senior high school (or above) graduates;
3. Foreign citizens who have passed HSK 4 or above;
4. Foreign citizens who obey laws both in home country and China.
